

FAQ's From TSA Leadership Conference - October 25, 2017

- 1) The Escape Room Sign-ups start at 7:30PM. The agenda on the inside of the brochures is the official schedule.
- 2) How do I ask questions via social media?
 - Advisor **and** may students sign up for snapchat and Instagram for messaging and pictures
 - Snapchat**
 - Go to snapchat ap
 - press the left corner for bitmoji
 - press add friends
 - Press snapcode and Scan snapchat code from brochure or badge (badge may not work if blurry)
 - Instagram**
 - Search for fltsa
- 3) Can I pay for FL TSA Leadership and State registrations using a p-card or credit card?
 - Yes, there should be a link on the FloridaTSA.com website for PayPal.
 - If you cannot find it, contact FLTSA.
- 4) Where can I find the details related to Florida State and National TSA Competitions?
 - For Florida TSA Leadership and State Conference – FloridaTSA.com
 - For National TSA Conference – tsaweb.org
- 5) Who do I contact if I have questions about Competition Event Guidelines (CEG aka CRG)
 - Everything is based on the National CEG. State Conferences may use all or a subset of the competitions – sometimes event modifications are made at the state level due to time or location constraints.
- 6) Who has District TSA Competitions?
 - Any region can host a District or Regional competition. Manatee County and Palm Bay offer district competitions. Both events are Dec 2, 2017; Mary Herring is the contact for Manatee County and Becky Allen is the contact for Palm Bay.
- 7) How do I find the CEG?
 - The CEG is updated every two years and HS and MS alternate years they are issued.
 - Only registered advisors with paid annual affiliation have official access to their CEG, MS or HS. Use the username and password that you set up for Total TSA during affiliation.
 - Tsaweb.org > Manage My TSA> Chapter Advisors>Total TSA>Login
- 8) Can we make Problem Solving competition more efficient?
 - Florida State Conference has the option to modify events due to time and location. We could set-up check-in for Technology Problem Solving Kits to give judges more time to evaluate toolboxes and materials. Florida TSA typically follows TSA National guidelines for dress code.
- 9) How do we get comment cards back to our chapters after Florida TSA State Competition?
 - An idea for FL TSA BOD is to enlist the help of a volunteer whose role focuses on providing feedback to chapters; the feedback could be specific to each entry or general feedback based on all entries.

10) What is the dress code for MS and HS for Florida TSA Leadership?

- Friday AM/PM – TSA Official Attire or Business Casual
- Friday Evening – Tribe T-shirts
